**NB : Using silicone sealant is not recommended for use on our panels. It will not stick sufficiently well to the laminate and degrades very quickly leaving the possibility of water ingress. If silicone has been used previously it must be chemically removed and cleaned before re-sealing with our recommended polymer sealant. Polymer sealant will not stick on any material that has silicone residue/film on the surface so we suggest using the following product to remove the silicone and any other residue.**
